The company now known as Mounting Systems GmbH was originally founded in 1993. In September 2008, Mounting Systems GmbH began operating as a separate company and has been selling its products independently ever since.

As of March 2012, another representative office has been available for customers in UK and in 2013 Mounting Systems opened a new facility in Japan.
